



REGISTER TO VOTE IN FLORIDA

To Register, You Must:



Be a US Citizen

Be a Florida Resident

Be 18 years old

You may pre-register to vote if you are 16 years old, but you cannot vote until you are 18 years old



Provide your current and valid Florida driver's license number or Florida identification card number

Not have been convicted of a felony without your civil rights having been restored

Not have been adjudicated mentally incapacitated



Where You Can Register to Vote:

Your County Supervisor of Election

Fill out an online application form on the Division of Elections' website:
www.dos.myflorida.com/elections

Any Florida driver's license office or tax collector's office that issues driver's licenses or Florida identification cards

Any "voter registration agency" (i.e., public library)

Any entity authorized by the Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission to issue permits for fishing, hunting or trapping
